

# **Manx Airsoft Club**

## **Rules & Regulations**

### ***Site limits:-***

- Maximum AEG (Automatic Electric Gun) shall not exceed a power level of 350 fps with a 0.2g bb.
- Single shot Sniper rifles shall not exceed 500fps with a 0.2g bb (with a minimum engagement range of 5m).
- Pyrotechnics (Grenades) shall not be used unless prior agreement & inspection by a committee member.
- All non club guns shall be inspected by a club committee member & chronographed prior to use on Manx Airsoft Club site.

### ***Safety :-***

- A full safety briefing will be given each game to new players, if you are a regular player please remain quiet until the briefing has ended.
- All players shall sign a disclaimer prior to playing on Manx Airsoft Club site.
- Prior to entering the safe zone, magazines shall be removed, actions cleared and weapons made safe.
- Approved safety masks or glasses must be worn at all times entering, leaving and within the play areas. If your own eye protection is not considered appropriate you will be issued with appropriate eye protection. Your eye protection shall be on before you pass through the safe zone exit, and stay on until you are back inside. 'Goggle lifting' during games is not acceptable and will count as a strike under the three strike system. If you have steamed up goggles, raise your rifle above your head & return to the safe zone you will be allowed to return to the game after clearing your goggles in the safe zone.
- Any discharging of guns in safe areas may result in immediate expulsion.
- Areas of the site of potential risk, such as the steep banks etc. These areas will be identified in the safety briefing; one of the reasons it is important that everyone is able to hear it. You may receive a strike under the three strike system if you are found to be obviously out of bounds.
- Age restriction for Manx Airsoft Club is 17, anyone under that age must be accompanied by a person aged 18 or over.
- Thirty pound (£30.00) membership fee & Five pound (£5.00) game fee is non-refundable, any member breaching M.A.C. rules may lose their membership status & money.
- By agreeing to be a member of Manx Airsoft Club you signify that you have read and agree to be bound by these rules. These rules may be changed without notice.

## **Gaming Rules:-**

- Airsoft relies on honesty - unlike paintball there is no mark left by Airsoft hits. Nothing ruins an Airsoft game faster than players not taking hits. Please help us to provide top quality Airsoft games by being an honest player.
- A hit occurs when a BB fired directly from a gun, or launched by a grenade or spring operated trap, strikes a player anywhere about their person or attire.
- Gun hits and definite ricochets do not count as hits, but all other areas (head, equipment, mask, fingers, feet etc) do.
- When you are hit, shout 'Hit' and raise your hand. Leave the game field keeping your arm raised to indicate to other players that you are out of the game. Do not linger in the game field. If medic rules are in place you lie were you are hit unless in direct fire from other players in which case you may move 'out of the fire zone'
- We play a 'surrender' or 'bang' rule. If you are likely to shoot a player at very short range, please give them a chance to surrender, or alternatively touch them and say 'bang' – this will count exactly the same as a hit with a BB. It hurts less, and makes you more popular.
- Use common sense in the application of this rule - do not try and 'sniper-bang' players who you could quite safely shoot.
- BB grenades and blank firing grenades will count as hit if they explode within 5 metres.
- Mark 9 thunderflashes may not be used. Mark 5 thunderflashes are fine.
- If you can get hard cover (like sandbags) between you and the grenade then you are safe. A bush is not hard cover.
- Grenades do normally make a large bang so please give your target the opportunity to cover their ears before you blow them up, by shouting 'Fire in the Hole!' or 'Grenade!'

## **Costs:-**

- We play Airsoft every 2 weeks between 12pm (noon) & 6pm (evening)
- Manx Airsoft Club is a non-profit club.
- We charge a £5 game fee which helps towards both club gun maintenance & site maintenance.
- An annual membership fee must be paid after you have completed 2 free games (£5.00 game fee must still be paid), after 2 free games you will be required to pay a non-refundable £30.00 annual membership fee (which goes towards Land rental & Club Insurance), which means you will be able to participate in all future Manx Airsoft Club games.
- Gun rental is £5.00 including face mask/goggles but is subject to availability & must be booked prior to gaming days.
- Manx Airsoft Club is NOT a commercial club & has limited guns for rental, do not be disappointed & make sure you reserve a gun!!!
